

Annual Town Meeting

April 2, 1946

At the town meeting held in the Town Hall in the City of Burlington April 2, 1946 the polls of election were opened at nine o'clock in the forenoon. A. C. Muegler, Bernard H. Ahler and Wm. Weis were inspectors of Election. Myron Chrzostek and Otto W. Yahnke were Clerks of Election. Ferdinand Richter and Henry A. Cook were ballot Clerks.

At 1:30 o'clock the Annual town meeting was held. Chairman A. C. Muegler called the meeting to order. The Supervisors annual report was read by the Clerk Otto W. Yahnke. Donald Eckert moved to adopt the report as read, seconded by Vern Robers. Motion carried. Donald Eckert moved that it be left to the town board to take care of the fire protection seconded by Henry Cook. Motion carried. Mr. Charles Jackson was called upon to explain all about the Burlington Rescue Squad. After the explanation Mr. Jackson mentioned that if the township of Burlington would make a donation toward said squad it would be greatly appreciated. John Moore moved that this also be left to the town board seconded by Henry Cook. Motion carried.

Motion was made and seconded that the town board purchase a new pickup truck for Highway purposes. Motion carried.

On no further business the meeting adjourned.

The town reserves the right to reject or except any or all bids for the benefit of the town, seconded by Bernard Ahler. Motion carried. Wm. Weis moved that Vern Robers be appointed for the coming year at the rate of \$.80 per hour same wages as last year seconded by Bernard Ahler, motion carried.
