

Special Board Meeting

May 2, 1946

In regard to adopting the Oakwood hills second Subdivision.

Meeting was called to order by Chairman A. C. Muegler. All Board members were present. Mr. Muegler Asked if there was any objection in the audience in regard to adopting this Subdivision.. Mr. E. J. Cook attorney for Mr. Martin Robers, replied that Mr. Martin Robers and Mr. Max Green had come to an agreement prior to this meeting in regard to the line fence after a lengthy discussion.

In consideration of the sum of \$275.00 paid to him by Max Green, Martin Robers does agree that so long as Max Green shall be the owner of property known as the Schuerman Farm said Martin Robers will maintain the division fences between the two properties with the understanding known that all materials for fencing now used in said fences may be used by Robers and that the division fence along the south side of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20 Town of Burlington the fence shall be rebuilt by Robers and maintained in the same position as same now is. That is it shall follow the line of the present fence as now maintained being fastened to trees in

The town board decided to adjourn this meeting until Monday morning at 9:00 o'clock.
