WHEREAS Wisconsin Southern Gas Company, a Wisconsin Corporation, is now furnishing and selling manufactured gas in the Township of Burlington, Racine County, Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS said Wisconsin Southern Gas Company proposes to substitute natural gas in lieu of manufactured gas for distribution and sale in the Township of Burlington, Racine County, Wisconsin.

THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BURLINGTON, RACINE COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: In accordance with the provisions of Section 196-58 (6) of the Wisconsin Statutes, Wisconsin Southern Gas Company and its successors and assigns, is hereby authorized to substitute natural gas for distribution and sale in the Township of Burlington, Racine County, Wisconsin, in lieu of manufactured gas, and such substitution of natural gas for manufactured gas is hereby approved.

Section 2: This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
