

Now therefore, be it resolved by the town board of the Town of Burlington, that is the sense and purpose of this resolution to authorize and direct that pursuant to section 70.65 (2) of the Wisconsin statutes the aggregate amount of state, County, and local taxes shall be carried in a single column in the tax roll opposite the parcel tract of land against which the tax is levied or, in case of personal property, in a single column opposite the name of the person, firm or corporation against whom the tax is levied.

It is further resolved and hereby authorized and directed that each tax bill or receipt shall show the purpose for which such taxes are to be paid, giving the percentage for state, county, and local taxes.

Mr. Vern Robers, Superintendant of Highways, presented the following report to the meeting:

Burlington, Wisconsin
December 11th, 1944.

To the Town Board of the town of Burlington,
Burlington, Wisconsin.

Gentlemen:

I have to report that during the year 1944 the town of Burlington has graded, gravel, oiled and in other ways worked upon and improved all of the main highways shown on the the plats of White Oak Park, and Oakwood Hills, two subdivisions of parts of sections 17, 18 and 19, township 2 north, range 19 east of the 4th P.M., in the town of Burlington.

I have further to report that the total milage of all of said highways worked as aforesaid, in said plats, according to measurements which I have just made, is five and four tenths (5.4) miles. This total milage exceeds by 2.17 miles the total milage of 3.23 miles in said plats heretofore credited to the town of Burlington by the State Highway Commission.

With this additional milage I believe that the total milage of roads and streets worked and maintained by the town of Burlington and for which the town should receive credit under the terms and provision of section 20.49 of the Revised Statutes is forty-six and twenty five hundredths (46.25) miles.

FURTHER SOLVED, that the Clerk of said Town is Hereby authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the County Treasurer of said Racine County.
